1.1 An Astrologer's Day

कथेचा सारांश: -

'एका ज्योतिषाचा दिवस' ही एका अशा ज्योतिषाची कहाणी आहे जो चिंचेच्या वृक्षाखाली आपला व्यवसाय चालवित होता. त्याने दुपारच्या सुमारास आपले काम सुरू केले. सर्वप्रथम आपली व्यावसायिक उपकरणे त्याने पसरविली, ज्यात एक इझन कवङ्या, त्यावर अस्पष्ट गूढ आकृत्या असलेला कपङ्याचा चौरस तुकडा, एक नोटबुक आणि पाल्मीरा लेखनाचे बंडल यांचा समावेश होता. त्याच्या कपाळावर पवित्र राख आणि शेंदूर चमकत होते. त्याचे मिशा काळ्या होत्या आणि डोळे चमकणारे होते. परिणाम व्हावा म्हणून त्याने डोक्यावर भगव्या रंगाची पगडीही घातली होती. तो अशा ठिकाणी बसला होता जिथे सर्व प्रकारचे लोक नेहमी येत असत. रस्त्याच्या दोन्ही बाजूंना अनेकविध प्रकारचे व्यवसाय व उद्योगधंदे चालत असत. त्याच्या जवळ शेंगदाणे विक्रेता त्याच्या मालाला वेगवेगळे नाव देऊन मोठ्याने ओरडत असे. त्याच्या शेंगदाण्यांना तो कधी 'बॉम्बे आईस्क्रीम' म्हणे तर कधी 'दिल्ली बदाम' किंवा 'शाही मेजवानी' म्हणत असे. लोकही त्याच्याकडे गर्दी करीत असत. यातील बरीचशी गर्दी ज्योतिष्याकडे रेंगाळत असे. जेव्हा अंधार पडायचा तेव्हा त्याला शेजारच्या शेंगदाणा विक्रेत्या कडून प्रकाश मिळायला लागायचा. नगरपालिकेने उजेडाची सोय केलेली नव्हती.

ज्योतिष्याने कोणताही विचार किंवा योजना न करता आपले गाव सोडले होते. जर तो तेथेच राहिला असता तर त्याने आपल्या पूर्वजांसारखेच काम: म्हणजे शेती करणे, लग्न करुन संसार करणे आणि आपल्या विडलोपार्जित घरात राहणे इ. केले असते. त्याच्याकडे प्रशिक्षणाची कमतरता असूनही, त्याच्याकडे चलाखपणा व धूर्तपणा होता. मानवी चिंतांची कारणे त्याला माहिती होती. लग्न, पैसा आणि मानवी संबंधांचे पेच ही कारणे समस्यांची असतात हे तो जाणून होता. म्हणूनच तो आपल्या ग्राहकांना खात्रीने प्रश्नांची उत्तरे देऊ शकत असे. प्रदीर्घ अभ्यासामुळे त्याची समज आणखी तीव्र झाली होती. पाच मिनिटातच ग्राहकाची समस्या तो जाणून घेत असे. प्रत्येक प्रश्नाचे तो ३ पै (जुने चलन) घेत असे. समोरची व्यक्ती कमीतकमी दहा मिनिटे बोलल्याशिवाय तो आपले तोंड उघडत नसे. त्यामुळे त्याला त्या व्यक्तीला देण्यासाठी अनेक उत्तरे व सल्ले मिळविता येत असत. ग्राहकाचा तळहात पाहून तो म्हणे, "तुमच्या कष्टांच्या तुलनेत हवे तेवढे यश तुम्हाला अनेक बाबतीत मिळत नाही." तेव्हा दहा पैकी नऊ तरी सहमत होत. किंवा तो विचारी, "तुमच्या कुटुंबात दूरच्या नात्यात अशी एखादी महिला आहे का जिचे तुमच्याशी सलोख्याचे संबंध नाहीत?" किंवा "तुमचे बहुतेक त्रास तुमच्या स्वभावामुळे होत आहेत अर्थात शिन या ठिकाणी असतांना तुम्ही वेगळे कसे असू शकणार म्हणा? तुमचा स्वभाव उतावळा आहे आणि तुमचं बाह्यस्वरूप कठोर वाटते." या अशा बोलण्यामुळे लोक लगेच खुश होत असत.

एकदा दिवसाची कामे पूर्ण करण्यापूर्वी एका व्यक्तीशी ज्योतिषाची चकमक झाली. आपला शत्रू सापडेल की नाही या प्रश्नाचे समाधानकारक उत्तर त्या माणसाला घ्यायचे होते. त्या अंधुक प्रकाशात ज्योतिषाने त्याला आपला शत्रू म्हणून ओळखले. तो माणूस हाच होता ज्याला ज्योतिषाने चाकू मारला होता व मरण्यासाठी विहिरीत ढकलले होते. ज्योतिषाने त्याच्याबरोबर सौदा केला. आठ आणे रक्कम देण्याचे त्या माणसाने मान्य केले मात्र जर चुकीचे उत्तर निघाले तर दुप्पट रक्कम दयावी लागणार होती. ज्योतिष्याने त्याच्या प्रश्नांना अशी खात्री पटणारी उत्तरे दिली की तो माणूस पूर्णपणे समाधानी झाला. ज्योतिषाने त्याला सांगितले की त्याच्या छातीत एकदा सुरा खुपसला गेला होता तसेच त्याला शेताजवळच्या विहिरीत मरायला सोडून दिले होते. त्याचे नाव गुरु नायक आहे हेही त्याने सांगितले. आपला शत्रू कधी सापडेल याविषयी ज्योतिषाने

त्याला सांगितले की त्याचा शत्रू एका लॉरीखाली दबला गेला आहे व त्याचा मृत्यू झाला आहे. त्यामुळे तो त्याला भेटणार नाही. आता आयुष्यात कोणताही धोका होऊ नये म्हणून त्याने कधीही दक्षिणेकडे प्रवास करु नये. अशा प्रकारे ज्योतिषाने त्याला निरोप दिला आणि त्या शत्रूपासून स्वतःची स्टका करून घेतली.


